Appendix One - About Camp Awesome

Camp Awesome is a summer camp program created by the Ottawa region of the United Church of Canada. Youth and young adult staff are mentored and supported as they develop a summer camp program. They then bring this program to churches across the region. These leaders are carefully chosen and screened. They will be taking leadership in the camp program. The leaders have experience working with children and in a summer camp setting. They will be creating a fun week of worship, Bible stories, crafts, games and more.

Camp Awesome staff will create a safe, welcoming and camp environment. They value creativity, care, faith, questions and fun. Each day, while including some surprises, will follow a pattern so that children feel at home in the routines and rhythms of camp.

In addition to the Camp Awesome staff, there will also be adult volunteers or staff from St. Mary Magdalene and Grace United Churches on site each day. The adults will be supporting the youth leaders, helping the children to feel welcome at camp, and are available in case of emergency. They will also be offering the before and after care programs. All adults working with children have completed a police records check. Many of the adult volunteers also helped at camp last year. We are looking forward to seeing kids from last year, as well as meeting new children!

Appendix Two - Things to Bring to Camp

We ask that you send your child to camp with...

- water bottle (can be re-filled at camp)
- nut-free lunch (snacks are provided by camp)
- sunscreen

- sweater and raincoat
- indoor shoes
- rubber boots or sturdy outdoor shoes for nature walks
